INNOVATIVE IDEA FILLS THE GAP

In Africa we see a gap in the community: boys and girls across the continent do not have access to footballs. Too often we see one coach working with 50-100 players using only a couple of balls. What would it look like for us to stand in that gap and to dream of a day where every child has access to a ball?

In Rwanda, our Ambassadors office had this conviction that having more footballs available for children would lead to more children being reached with the gospel of Jesus. So, they did the research and started producing balls that can stand against the toughness of some African fields. To date they have trained 26 ball makers and made 356 footballs, providing jobs to some coaches and parents of the children we reach out to, and giving more opportunity to communicate the love of Jesus through this beautiful game.



Africa - In Africa there are more and more opportunities to partner with large denominations whose pastors and volunteers are being empowered to use football for discipleship. We see kingdom impact on a greater scale than ever before. With a focus on developing coaches as father figures and disciple makers we make sure that the kind of impact we have is not just wide, but deep and holistic. Multiplying discipleship through football ministry is reaching a predominant fatherless generation as Christ followers.



Did you know?

In August over 1,000 boys and girls attended the Rwanda National Football Camp, with all their footballs made by the Rwanda office. Even the Federation leader was impressed with the quality of the balls.

STEPPING OUT IN FAITH

How do we impact the players in our clubs? Discipleship is key. We do this by sharing God's Word, living out our faith, and getting the kids outside of their comfort zones and giving them a chance to minister as well.

Over the past few years, a number of women's teams have gone out from the Cleveland office to variouse countries around the world. Inspired by that history and seeing what these teams were doing, we were able to assemble a high school girls team from the club in Cleveland to travel to Ireland. The team's outreach included playing several matches, ministering to over 1,900 children at schools, helping at a church football camp, and serving with a local church. Some of the believers on the team shared their testimony for the first time while the Gospel was shared a number of times through skits and talks with the other teams.

Our club is dreaming and planning to make tours like this happen on a regular basis.



The Americas - One of the words we use to describe what Ambassadors does is Mobilize. Over 300 young men and women served in US programs this summer. Over 20 countries were represented in various programs. Throughout the USA over 1,700 children and their families were impacted through our programs. Groups went to Mexico, Germany (to minister to Ukrainian refugees), Costa Rica, Holland, Ireland and South Africa. Young people are being envisioned, trained, and mobilized to impact the next generation.

MAKING DISCIPLES IN INDIA

Joseph, our leader in India has been training coaches across the country to become disciple makers. The training is focused on helping coaches to understand the essence of the Great Commission. The coaches gain insight and the skills needed to train others from different sectors of society in how to use football as ministry. This past August 22 aspiring coaches from 13 different cities across India participated at a week-long training event in Kalimpong, West Bengal.

One coach told Joseph, "Football is my passion and doing ministry through football is my calling. This training has given me lots of insights on how to do this for His glory." Other coaches agreed that the training is great for making disciples, "It will surely help more believers to grow in their spiritual life and build God's Kingdom by sharing the Good News."



Asia - Making disciples who then make disciples. This vision has helped our leaders across the region to work in partnership with like-minded organizations and churches. This has enabled us to reach out to children, youth, and young adults in different communities, churches, schools, and colleges through football ministry.

GROWING MINISTRY IN SPAIN

Ambassadors Football Spain has flourished in Granada, Spain since the year 2000. Throughout the years, they've expanded to three other cities nearby. Last year God surprised us through a partnership with YWAM that led to a football ministry in Bilbao, in the north of Spain.

Bilbao is in the Basque Country, which is very different from the other regions because of its desire for independence from Spain. The city breathes football and stops every time there's a match of Athletic de Bilbao, their biggest team. This has created a great opportunity to use football as ministry in Bilbao and the work has begun.

The Ambassadors Football ministry in Bilbao is flourishing so much so that in less than a year they've had their first tournament with more than 50 participants. We're seeing God opening doors in Spain and we're excited that His Word is being preached in places like the Basque Country through the Ambassadors Football Ministry.



Europe - The roots of Ambassadors Football ministry in Spain are firmly planted in the city of Granada. The ministry group there has a very strong futsal (a 5 vs. 5 version of football played on a court similar to a basketball court) ministry that reaches many youth who would never attend church. This ministry has seen many marginalized youth come to know Jesus as their Savior. For the past six years Ambasadors Football Great Britain has taken a team to Granada to minister alongside of them through futsal.

Bilbao is the largest city of the Basque Country, with 350,000 people.

The second largest city is Vitoria-Gasteiz with more than 238,000 people.
