Frequently Asked Questions:

The aims of the festival are to provide an opportunity for people to hear the Gospel, encourage fellowship and provide a quality tournament to support your church outreach.

Format: This is naturally determined by the number of teams that enter, but traditionally matches last either 25-30 minutes one way or 20 minutes each way.

In the last few years, we have mixed Category A teams, with Category B teams on the first day. Depending on where they finish in the group they will qualify for the Cup or the Plate. Ambassadors and the teams have preferred this format.

Lunch Time Talks: There will be a lunch time break where there will be a Gospel talk, please bring all players to come and listen.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome to come and watch your team play.

Surface: Played on grass pitches

Team Size: This is an 11-a-side tournament. We recommend having around 15 players for the weekend.

Start & finish time: Again, flexible based on the number of teams entering but usually on Saturday from 10am to 5pm and Sunday 10am to 4pm.

Referees: We strive to provide qualified Referees.

Leadership: All teams must represent a Church and as such the team leadership are expected to be mature Christians.

Shin Pads: All players must wear shin pads.

Food/Catering: There is food available at the university's café and shop.

Fixtures: All fixtures will be emailed out a week before the event for your information.

Accommodation: Is provided by Harper Adams University, details on how to book will be given once team booking is confirmed.

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
